We are also in great need fore more people to help with hospitality ministry by helping with a cuppa after Mass. If you feel you can help with this please **contact Martin on 0421 525232.**

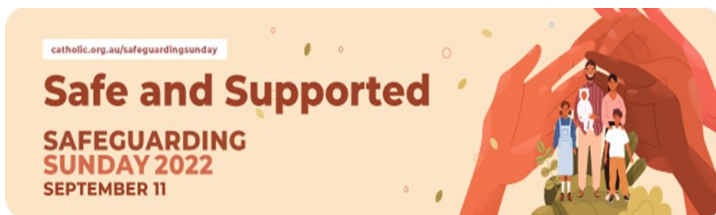
