The disciples had started off from the Jewish side of the Sea of Galilee, familiar territory. Jesus guided them through the stormy situation to 'the other side', the pagan side, unfamiliar territory where they would not have felt at home. Some of the storms include a new attitude to authority, to gender roles. There is anger and suspicion at sexual abuse and its

cover up. Many of our contemporaries are openly hostile or contentedly indifferent. In all these situations and many more, Our Lord will not allow us the indulgence of nostalgic yearning for the safety of the past country inhabited by the Church. We are not to throw Tradition with a capital 'T' overboard. To jettison the spirit-led experience of the Church over two millennia will not help us. Discerning tradition from nostalgia, we must make our way to the other shore.

We could pause for a moment, resolving to row with courage because we know we are in the same boat as Peter whom our Risen Lord assures:

'Do not be afraid.'

ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

As this is a holy day of obligation, there will be Mass for the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Sacred Heart Church at Booval on <u>Tuesday 15th August at 6:30pm.</u>

Hope and Joy are features of the celebration of the Assumption and the readings today confirm this hope for all people through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Magnificat which is Mary's song, copies Hannah's song who is the mother of the prophet Samuel, which draws together the yearnings and desires of past and future people. It is Mary's wholehearted and absolute compliance in participating in God's purpose that makes her physical assumption into heaven a beacon of hope for everyone. May we always be ready to willingly participate in God's purpose for us.
